

Procedure for Entering Cleveland Institute of Art's Gund Building

Address: 11610 Euclid Avenue, Cleveland OH 44106

Step 1: Enter your health-screening assessment using the CampusClear app prior to arriving at CIA. If you are not exhibiting any symptoms, the app will provide you with a smiley face entrance pass, which you'll show to the security guard upon entering the building. The self-screening should take less than 10 seconds each day. [Download instructions](#) on how to install and use the free [CampusClear app](#). **Please note: you can select the visitor option in the app if you are not a current student or employee.**

Step 2: Free parking is available in Lot 73. Entrances A and B are open Mon–Sat: 7am to midnight. Entrance C is open only during public hours (Saturdays from noon - 5pm) and during Cinematheque screenings.

Step 3: Have your temperature taken and face covering verified. Upon entry to the building, you will have your temperature taken by an automated kiosk. The automated kiosk will also verify that you're wearing a face covering.

Step 4: Receive a building-access wristband. The wristband will be color-coded and date-stamped. Once you have the wristband, you will not need to display the entrance pass in the app or get your temperature taken again in the event you need to re-enter the building that day.
